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


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Pb/Cd/Hg/Cr6+/PBBs/PBDEs Testing Flow Chart

1) These samples were dissolved totally by pre -conditioning method according to below flow chart. (Cr6+ and PBBs/PBDEs test method excluded).





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
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Phthalates Testing Flow Chart





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
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HBCDD Testing Flow Chart





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
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PFOA / PFOS Testing Flow Chart





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


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
